The Fergusson Fund Media Scholarship

- Taranaki Foundation administers The Fergusson Fund Media Scholarship, established in 2024.
- The \$10,000 grant supports one Taranaki student pursuing full-times studies in journalism, photography, communications, or related media fields.
- As part of the scholarship the successful applicant will complete up to three weeks work placement with the Taranaki Daily News throughout the year.
- The grant is distributed in two instalments: 50% of the start of studies and 50% upon successful completion of the year.
- Please note scholarship amounts are indicative only and may vary from the amount stated.

Application Process

- Please submit your application and supporting documents to: info@taranakifoundation.org.nz **between 1 September and 31 October.**
- The application period may be extended at Taranaki Foundation's discretion.
- All applicants will be notified by Taranaki Foundation by the end of November.
- Shortlisted applicants will be invited to an informal interview with representatives from Taranaki Foundation and Taranaki Daily News.
- Grant recipients will be required to report on the use of funds using the Taranaki Foundation's Accountability Report.
