## **Centenary Celebrations**

Secondary education began in Opunake in 1920 with nine students being taught at St. Barnabas Church Hall. The roll quickly grew to 57 students and by 1928, a block of buildings consisting of one classroom, a laboratory, a cooking room and a woodwork room were built on the current High School grounds. In 1956, Opunake District High School became a full high school, appointing its first principal, Mr. R.C. Griffiths. The school's motto, "Growing good people for a rapidly changing world," reflects its commitment to providing opportunities to learn and train to be the best rangatahi our young people can be.

As Ōpunakē High School prepares to celebrate a century of educating the youth of coastal Taranaki, this Fund will play a part in the Taranaki Anniversary Weekend 2025 Centenary Celebrations.

## How the Fund Works

The Ōpunakē High School Fund is managed by the Taranaki Foundation. Donations are invested permanently, preserving the capital indefinitely.

Your donation or bequest to the Ōpunakē High School Fund will help provide funding, support and assistance for the benefit and welfare of the school and/or education, learning, cultural and sporting activities at the School.
